Treasurer's Report - Director Killion

Cash on hand at the end of April 30, 2019, \$2,108,295. Year to date is favorable at \$107,639.00.

Account at FCB has been closed.

<u>Manager's Report</u> – Scott Feldkamp (Manager)

Manager Feldkamp had a brief report: We are a full six (6) weeks ahead of last year's mowing schedule. The 3rd cycle is well underway. The Community Center is almost two years old. We averaged 70 events monthly this winter. Over 100 people visit Broadmoor Park every day. Some days we've counted 250 people. Hundreds of new trees and shrubs have been planted so far this spring. Sixty (60) more trees to go. The millions of wildflowers planted in Broadmoor Park last year are springing to life. The roadside parks, entrances and bridges, all got fresh plants, gravel and mulch.

Russ Kulp and I are working on the website transition. Good positive progress.

Andy V., Steve F. and I are working on a sound system resolution, microphones & recorder. Expenses are below budget. Income: exceeds budget. Reserves: will be fully funded in May, 2019. The new aeration fountain in East Lake will be installed within the next two (2) weeks.

Two properties were foreclosed. Payment received from one; the other closes 7-19-2019. The aquatic plants added to the shorelines at each of the roadside parks are multiplying. Planning is on schedule and funding for the Rotonda Summer Festival is at 60% of its goal. The Plizga woodworking company has two new display board, kiosks almost complete. Oh, yeah ... another mile of walking trails have been completed in Broadmoor Park.
